This is ONLY place to see additional media projections, as Alvas Showroom is beautifully equipped to add lights and media that won't be seen in the outside festival. Media will be seen from Nicole Mathis-Berman, Director of White Crane Dance Theatre. Louise Reichlin & Dancers shows excerpts from "The Patchwork Girl of Oz", and the rarely seen *Ritual* section of "The Tennis Dances" based on the Jack Jones cult at the time the piece was choreographed (1979). CalliOpus Contemporary Dance presents a work "Salty Blood" choreographed by Joseph Lister. It was created in response to the Montecito Mud Slides where it premiered in the festival "Dance For Montecito". It is a group contemporary piece where the lead female is representing ocean wild life - for example, a dolphin. The rest of the cast is ocean pollution and oil spills. Nivedita SV & Anusha G present BHARATANATYAM (Indian classical dance). Dion M. Pratt presents a solo.
